Base Map Imagery Source and Date: U.S. Department of Agriculture, National Agriculture Imagery Program, 2015 **Establishment of Unit**: The area proposed for inclusion within new OPA Unit NJ-02P is currently within the boundaries of existing System Unit NJ-02, which was established by the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act (CBIA) (Pub. L. 101-591 enacted on November 16, 1990).

Proposed new Unit NJ-02P meets the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (CBRA) criteria for an undeveloped coastal barrier (16 U.S.C. 3503(g) (1)) and is consistent with the CBRA definition of an OPA, which is an area "established under Federal, State, or local law, or held by a qualified organization, primarily for wildlife refuge, sanctuary, recreational, or natural resource conservation purposes" (Section 12 of the CBIA; Pub. L. 101-591).

Proposed Unit: The comprehensively revised draft map dated May 16, 2016, creates new OPA Unit NJ-02P. Included within this new unit is a portion of Old Bridge Waterfront Park, which is owned by the Township of Old Bridge.
