Hi Liam,

You are correct -- the temporary rule changes are due, in part, to those same owls! Typically we will see these types of intrusive viewing behaviors for snowy owls, but the barred owls now are too close and convenient for most photographers to resist.

Regarding the Pink House, it has indeed been a long slog with many ups and downs. We are in the process of identifying additional lands for an exchange -- both in MA and in NH. In NH specifically, we are looking to establish Great Thicket National Wildlife Refuge for the first time using possible future Pink House exchange funds. As I have relayed to the Pink House group, we, too, have a vested interest in seeing this deal through, so it remains a high priority. I will let you know of any significant developments as they arise.

Finally, you may have already met Jennifer Joseph, our congressional and legislative affairs specialist. But if not, I am cc'ing her here by way of an introduction.
