Greg,

Bob Boekelheide and I, representing the Olympic Peninsula Audubon, have been in consultation with Hansi Hals and Liz Tobin of the Jamestown S’Klallam Tribe regarding the monitoring of re-establishing their Dungeness Bay oyster farm.

We have informed Hansi and Liz that we do not have the capacity to perform the monitoring specified in the monitoring plan. We have outlined to them the capabilities we could offer and some alternatives. We are awaiting their evaluation of our response.

We have not been informed of the USFWS response to monitoring requests, and how they could, or could not, involve Olympic Peninsula Audubon.

To best of my knowledge, that is the status today.
