Here is a more complete series of photos showing mice attacking an ashy storm-petrel chick in Bat Cave. If you move through the photos, you can see the chick appear in the middle/lower left side as the mice "run around". As you move through the photos the mice start jumping on the back of the chick. Unfortunately, the action moves offscreen so we don't know the end result but to me this is a pretty clear case of mice attacking storm-petrels. Still waiting for the team to send me photos of egg depredation. Will forward those as soon as I get them.
