

Two Rivers Wind Energy Project

On **November 9, 2022**, in response to the applications from Two Rivers Wind, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of BluEarth Renewables US, LLC, the Service is publishing a draft Environmental Assessment (EA) along with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) for two 30-year incidental eagle take permits (IETPs) under the Eagle Act.

The combined 79-wind turbine project is being proposed on 20,157 acres of the Two Rivers Ranch (private), interspersed with parcels of land administered by the State of Wyoming Office of State Lands and Investments (OSLI), and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Rawlins Field Office, located in Carbon and Albany Counties, Wyoming.
